



Niamh has been cast to play the role of Nina in the new Channel 5 series THE TEACHER 2, directed by Dominic Leclerc. She most recently filmed the role of Siobhan in THE LISTENERS, for Element Pictures, alongside Rebecca Hall and directed by Janicza Bravo.

Further screen credits include the role of Annette Zandveld in THE HOUSE ACROSS THE STREET directed by Dominic Leclerc for Channel Five.

Niamh's stage work includes performances in Dead Centre's Dublin Theatre Festival Show GOOD SEX, written by Emilie Pine, directed by Ben Kidd with intimacy co-ordinator Sue Mythen. Just prior she played the role of Mrs. O'Dea alongside Owen Roe in Sebastian Barry's THE STEWARD OF CHRISTENDOM directed by Louise Lowe at the Gate Theatre, Dublin.

Further credits include ANU's THE PARTY TO END ALL PARTIES directed by Louise Lowe; THE FALL OF THE SECOND REPUBLIC directed by Annie Ryan for the Abbey Theatre; Dylan Tighe's PASOLINI'S SALÒ REDUBBED at the Abbey, and A CHRISTMAS CAROL directed by Selina Cartmell for the Gate Theatre, Dublin. Niamh is a long term collaborator & performer with ANU and has performed in over nine productions, including award winning works LAUNDRY (2011), ANGEL MEADOW (2014) THESE ROOMS, and most recently THE ANVIL for the Manchester International Festival 2019.

Screen credits include THE CLINIC (RTÉ) and HOLBY CITY (BBC) RIVER CITY (BBC), and LITTLE ROY (CBBC). Film credits include John Crowley's BAFTA & Oscar Nominated BROOKLYN, & THE CURED Directed by David Freyne. Previous writing and creation of solo work includes WELCOME TO THE FORTY FOOT. Niamh is primarily Dublin based, but also has a London base.

Niamh trained as an Actor at The Guildhall School of Music & Drama, London. She began her career at the prestigious Shakespeare's Globe Theatre in London, returning for several seasons thereafter, and has worked consistently with some of the leading theatre companies in the UK and Ireland, including the National Theatre, Royal Shakespeare Company, The Lyceum Edinburgh, Gate Theatre Dublin, Rough Magic, Abbey Theatre and ANU Productions.
